What is a bequest?

Leaving a gift in your will is a deep and meaningful gesture; please ensure you speak with your family or loved ones (if appropriate) before beginning this process. As well, be sure to speak to your lawyer or financial planner about your intentions. Below are some sample wordings that you may use for your will:

"I give _____ to support the work of The Brenda Strafford Foundation, charitable registration number 105198873RR0001".

Or

"I bequeath the residue of my Estate (or ___%) to The Brenda Strafford Foundation, charitable registration number 105198873RR0001".

You can designate your gift to a specific program or service area.
