The Brenda Strafford Foundation has a very proud history (starting in 1975) based on an overarching intent to serve marginalized populations and those in need. Dr. Strafford enshrined this intent by developing guiding statements and documents that form the legacy and guiding tenets of the organization as follows:

Our Philosophy

The preservation of dignity and the pursuit of happiness.

The Guiding Principle

To cater to Humanity; to bring a measure of hope to people whose outlook seems hopeless.

The Foundation's Objectives (as originally filed with Canada Revenue Agency and supported in subsequent documents)

- To carry on the operation of the Manors in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations.
- To establish and carry on the operation of medical clinics to provide care and facilities for the poor and needy.
- To promote other charitable causes, including without limited the generality thereof, the advancement or education, the relief of poverty and advancement of other purposes of a charitable nature beneficial to the community as a whole.
- To receive and maintain a fund or funds and apply from time to time all or part thereof and/or the income therefrom for charitable purposes.
- To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objectives.

The Governing Body aims to realize its charitable objectives by:

- Dedicating all funds, including those realized from investments, to the service of humanity.
- Maintaining a sound financial base in order to expand the charitable works of the Foundation.
- Seeking investments in support of these objectives, especially investments which will, in turn contribute to health care in Canada.
- Actively exploring new opportunities to benefit humanity, especially in situations where extreme poverty exists.
